Reporting Process

We have established procedures for reporting concerns or suspicions of modern slavery or human trafficking, including a confidential whistleblowing policy available to all employees, suppliers, and other stakeholders.

Monitoring and Compliance

We monitor compliance with our policies and procedures related to modern slavery and human trafficking on an ongoing basis and conduct regular audits of our supply chains to identify and address any potential risks.
